In this webinar, Olcay Sert will use samples of video recordings from different English language classrooms to show the importance of ‘Classroom Interactional Competence’ for effective language teaching.

He will argue that the ways teachers (1) ask questions, (2) respond to student utterances, (3) provide correction and feedback, (4) manage student silence, and (5) use gestures and other visual resources are all key for creating language learning opportunities in classrooms.

Taking part in this webinar, hopefully, will help teachers to raise their awareness on the relationship between interaction and learning.
